- 1 Phebe daughter of Charles & Sarah Covert died Jan 18 1816 aged 8 yrs 5 mos & 25 ds
- 2 Fanny dau of William & Cornelia Ely died Feb 27 1840 2 yrs & 9 mo & 25 ds
- 3 _____(corner of stone missing, probably Jacob) son of Charles & Sarah Covert died Sept 28 18__ 2 mo & 9 d
- 4 In memory of Mercy wife of David Coleman who died Sept 29 1838 age 33 yrs 7 mos 5 ds
- 5 Phebe P. wife of David Coleman died March 25 1812 aged _____yrs
- 6 Robert Curry died Jan'y 30 1848 aged 76 yrs.
- 7 Abe. wife of Robert Curry died 29 Nov 1843 aged 71 yrs & 0 mos & 10ds
- 8 George R. son of William & Cornelia Ely died May 15 1835 (The small headstone GRE noted on the original list appears to be a footstone for this grave.)
- 9 William Ely died Sept 22 1837 aged 42 years
- 10 Fanny wife of Wm Ely died Dec 29 1829 aged 33 yrs & 7ds
- 11 Memory of Simeon son of Robert & Abe Curry who died Sept 26 1830 aged 20 years 4 mos 22ds. These ruins & remains are precious in our eyes. These ruins shall be built again and all their dust shall rise. Carver E B Smith

- 12 Memory of Levi son of Robert & Abe Curry who died April 14th 1827 aged 15 yrs 1 mo 25 dys. Farewell my son the God who gives has claimed his own. And I must join my loving God and taste death alone. (The headstone L C with decoration appears to be the footstone of this grave.)
- 13 James S. son of Nicholas & Anna Wickoff died Feb 13 1842 ag'd 7 yrs 1 mo & 13 dys O death why strike so soon, why me so young, so lonely
- 14 In memory of Mr. William Junr son of Wm& Elizabeth Marlatt who died Sept 29, 1828 aged 27 yrs 7 mos 14ds. I sleep in dust and soon must rise. Prepare to meet me in the skies.
- 15 Unknown , Name possibly William, died June 6 1812
- 16 In memory of James A son of Alanson & Mary Fausett who died Sept 18 1834
- 17 In memory of Amanda dau of Alanson & Mary Fausett who died July 1 1839 age 3 yrs 8 mos
- 18 Anna wife of _____ Wickoff died Dec 25 1813 42 yrs 3 mos & 16 ds
- 19 William Curry a soldier of the Revolution died May 6 1844 aged 95 years, 10 mos 5 days Blessed are the dead who died in the Lord.
