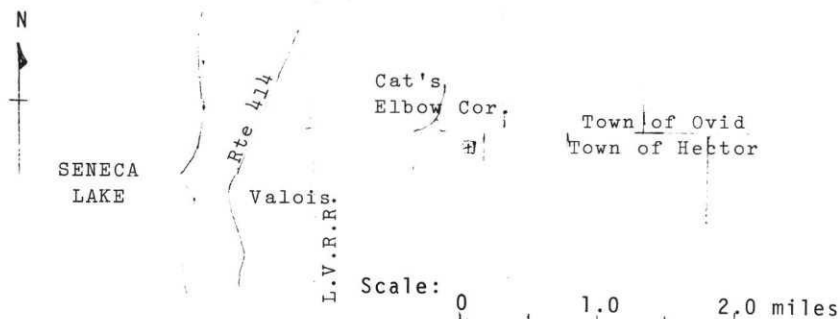


OLD CLAWSON BURYING GROUND
Town of Hector, N.Y.



"One mile north of Valois [formerly North Hector] on Route 414 (1951 maps) turn to the right going up the hill and over the R.R. tracks on the Lodi-Hector Town Line Road, for about 1-1/2 miles. Here the road forks, and taking the right fork around what is called cat's elbow, which crosses a ravine, the road climbs for at least another 1/2 mile. On the southwest corner, where a road comes in from the south, this plot is located. It is said the stones are easily seen in winter, but in summer this is not so, although they are near the edge of the road - perhaps 100 ft." JHF

The above map was made from the U.S. Geological Survey Map of 1902. The *Atlas of Schuyler Co. N.Y.* by Pomeroy, Whitman & Co. Phila. 1874 does not show the cemetery but does show I.B. Clawson owning the farm next east and J. Swarthout the farm next west - CWF

Henry V. son of Garrit & Lydia d Aug 6 1831 ae 1-11-25
Garret B. d June 7 1832 aged 44 years 5 months 9 days
Silvernale, Margaret died July 10 1825 aged 84 years

Latest stone noted - 1842

Note: in all cases died, years, months, & days were spelled out.
